OPEN MEETING ITEMS

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: William J. Edwards, Peter J. Hutchison, Patrick T. Tyrrell, Martin A. Pedersen, Stanton J. Abell, Jr., David L. Whitman, Richard C. Moore.

STAFF MEMBERS PRESENT: Christine Turk, Executive Director; Jennifer Wilhelm, Licensing Officer; and Kennard F. Nelson, Sr. Asst. Attorney General.

Mr. Edwards opened the meeting by introducing Richard C. Moore, as the newly appointed member of the Board.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A motion was made by Martin A. Pedersen, seconded by David L. Whitman to approve the minutes with corrections noted at meeting. Motion passed six to one. Mr. Moore abstained.

APPROVAL OF BUDGET AND TREASURER REPORTS: A motion was made by Martin A. Pedersen, seconded by Peter J. Hutchison and carried to accept the Budget and Treasurer Reports as distributed.

COMMENTS ON RULES AND REGULATIONS: A motion was made by Martin A. Pedersen, seconded by Patrick T. Tyrrell and carried to sustain review of the submitted comments until September meeting. The cut-off for submittal of comments is August 15, 2003.

STAFF INVESTIGATOR: Patrick T. Tyrrell advised the Board that the original plan to hire a staff investigator had been changed due to government restrictions on contract employees. Instead, the Board will be advertising for a consultant through the Request for Proposal (RFP) system. Martin A. Pedersen will work with Christine Turk and Kennard F. Nelson developing the language for the RFP.

As a result of the restriction on hiring a Contract employee, Ms. Turk requested authorization from the Board to proceed with the installation of a work station so that if the Consulting Investigator does not have a personal home office, they could come to the Board office when needed to access files and complete reports. The Board agreed to proceed with the proposed work station.

CPC AUDIT RESPONSES:

John E. Parks - A motion was made by Richard C. Moore, seconded by Patrick T. Tyrrell to accept the submittal of Mr. Parks. Motion passed four to three.

Eldon D. Strid - A motion was made by David L. Whitman, seconded by Patrick T. Tyrrell, and carried to accept the submittal of Mr. Strid.

Robert H. Stratton - A motion was made by Richard C. Moore, seconded by Martin A. Pedersen and carried to reduce number of carry-over hours by eight due to non acceptance of the active participation in professional and technical societies. One must serve as an officer to claim time in that category.

Vern K. Heisler - A motion was made by Patrick T. Tyrrell, seconded by Martin A. Pedersen and carried to accept Mr. Heisler's submittal.

A motion was made by Patrick T. Tyrrell, seconded by Richard C. Moore and carried to change the CPC Reporting Form so that the registrant can clearly identify the carry-over hours being used. In addition, the motion included changing the form to include a statement that all CPC Credits earned during the renewal period must be submitted prior to year-end, or the credits will not be accepted. Also, the CPC Reporting Form should bear the date the registrant signs.

NCEES ANNUAL MEETING: Patrick T. Tyrrell will not be attending the NCEES Annual Meeting this year. All other members will be in attendance. Christine Turk will be attending, and the associated costs will be funded by the NCEES.

APEGGA TO VISIT WYOMING BOARD: Christine Turk advised the Board that representatives from the Association of Professional Engineers, Geologists, and Geophysicists of Alberta have requested time at the Board's September meeting to make a presentation on licensure in Canada.

ELSEES: Christine Turk advised the Board that the arrangements with Engineering and Land Surveying Examination Services are moving smoothly towards beginning to administer the national exams for Wyoming. Beginning with the October 2003 examination, all professional exams will be administered in Casper, Wyoming; and all Fundamental Exams will be administered at the University in Laramie.

TODD RHODES: The Board received information that Wyoming Water Rights Consulting, Inc., may be advertising to provide engineering and land surveying services without benefit of registration. Stanton J. Abell, Jr., presented the brochure in question to the Board for review. After reviewing and discussing the advertisement, a motion was made by Martin A. Pedersen, seconded by Patrick T. Tyrrell, and carried to advise Mr. Rhodes that the language in his advertising brochure is in violation of Wyoming statutes. The Board will advise Mr. Rhodes that he should immediately change the wording in his brochure to indicate that he can recommend or subcontract engineering or land surveying services and to remove that the company can provide the services.

REINSTATEMENT OF APPLICATIONS: Martin A. Pedersen discussed with the Board his desire to require a new application and application materials for all individuals who allow their license to expire. At the present time, the policy is that for the first two years an individual may reinstate his license by simply paying the renewal fee, plus late fees. After two years, the individual has to complete the front and back of an application form, but does not have to submit references, etc. The Board directed Christine Turk to question other jurisdictions on their requirements, as well as to check the NCEES Model Law.

ELECTRICAL V.S. COMPUTER ENGINEERING: A name change in the National Electrical Engineering Exam prompted a question from Christine Turk to the Board. The National Exam is now referred to as Electrical/Computer Engineering. Ms. Turk wanted to know if the Board would change the registration discipline from Electrical, to Electrical/Computer Engineering. The Board indicated that the discipline an individual is licensed in will be the name of the exam. Thus, Electrical/Computer Engineering will be the discipline registered.

BOARD SALARY: A motion was made by Martin A. Pedersen and seconded by Peter J. Hutchison, to begin immediately paying the Board their salary for time spent attending any meetings directly related to Board business. The motion passed five to two. Mr. Tyrrell and Mr. Moore voted against the motion until further study of the budgetary impact could be done. Mr. Pedersen requested that Christine Turk obtain information regarding how legislators are paid and report to the Board.

CORRESPONDENCE FROM JAMES D. WHITE, PE #3150: Mr. White wrote to the Board advising that while attempting to design his own wastewater treatment system in Sublette County Wyoming, he was told by the County Planner that the design of such systems are done solely by the County Sanitarian. Mr. White wanted to know if he is in fact prohibited from designing his own wastewater treatment system. The Board agreed that Mr. White should be allowed to design his own system. A motion was made by Martin A. Pedersen, seconded by Patrick T. Tyrrell to have Stanton J. Abell, Jr., and Kennard Nelson, Board attorney, discuss this matter with the Department of Environmental Quality and write a letter to Sublette County authorities. Mr. White will also receive a response.

SCHEDULE OF NEXT BOARD MEETING: The Board will meet on September 15, 2003 in Thermopolis, Wyoming.
